NOTES

1. One man in each squadron will be trained up to the standard of a shoemaker group 'C' class III and will be eligible to draw the rates of pay of a tradesman, group 'C', class III, only on those days on which he is employed at that trade.
2. One driver, I.C. in each reconnaissance squadron will be trained up to the standard of an equipment repairer, and will be eligible to draw the rates of pay of an equipment repairer, only on those days on which he is employed at the trade
3. At least 1 officer and 12 men will be trained in anti-gas duties and decontamination work.
